

# ROURKIE'S Cat and Fiddle Route

0	Brian Rourke Cycles Turn left onto Waterloo Road A50 through Burslem, Tunstall, Goldehill to Kidsgrove
5	Pass Tesco supermarket and lights At the next traffic lights turn right A34 signed Congleton Continue to Congleton, follow A34 through 2 roundabouts
9.5	At Lights, continue straight on signed Manchester/Macclesfield
10	At the Grove Inn large roundabout take right hand lane signed A536 Macclesfield - continue
15	Turn right at sign Gawsworth Hall and Sutton in Church Lane Immediate 1st left signed Sutton Woodhouse End Road
17	At T-junction opposite Fools Nook Pub turn left to join main Macclefield/Leek Road A523
18	Lights Continue
19	Lights Continue over raised ramp signed Stockport
20	Lights A537 Buxton Road directly in front of the Arighi Bianchi furniture store [This is start of the climb]
26	Cafe on left hand side Peak View, excellent tea and cakes!
27	Cat and Fiddle Pub top of climb Continue on the Buxton Road A54 - take car on decent
30	T-Junction of A53 Bixton to Leek road - turn right to Leek Take great care on fast decent onto Leek Continue up this road to climb over Axe Edge
32	Top of Axe Edge climb continue to on the way to Leek
35	Take great care on fast decent on way to Leek
40	Leek follow road past Co-op supermarket to Lights Next lights take left hand turn signed Stoke A53
45	Turn right signed Brown Edge Clay Lake Road Pass through Brown Edge, Norton Green, Norton
48	Climb Smallthorne Bank. At top, take slight left then immediately go straight over roundabout down road by Starbucks Coffee and Calor Gas depot
50	At lights turn right direction Burslem and Tunstall - North road then 1st left Ashbourne Street straight over at Davidson street and through bollards to Waterloo Road - Brian Rourke Cycles is directly in front if you.
55	Well Done! Please sign off.
